Even once they had finally moved to Florida, King still returned occasionally to Chicago for business, and, as we shall see, to take hundreds of reference images of the landscape, region and city that had inspired his comic strip from the beginning.















1911 February 7th: Frank King and Delia Drew marry. King is 27, Delia is 26. Walter Drew moves to Chicago.
