I didn't expect to cry.



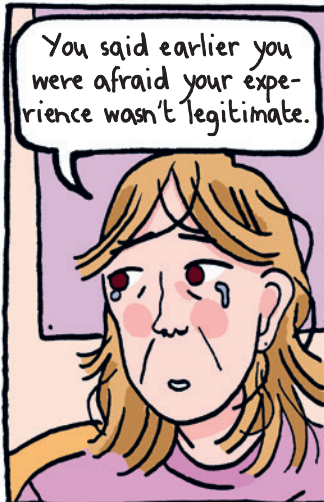
Don't worry. It's a very common reaction.
